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DAY 1

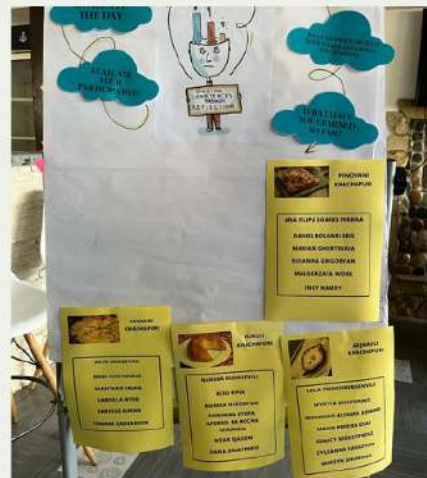


Getting to know each other

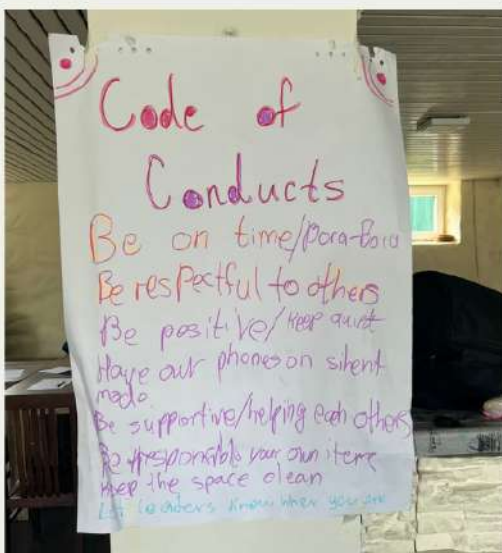
Reflection groups

Then we had a team building activity which helped us to become more ready to work within teams. Also, we created reflection groups to talk about our expectations and thoughts.



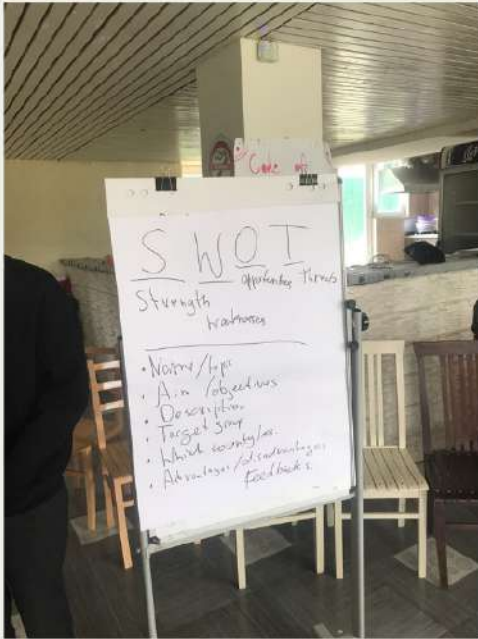
Code of conducts

Advertising

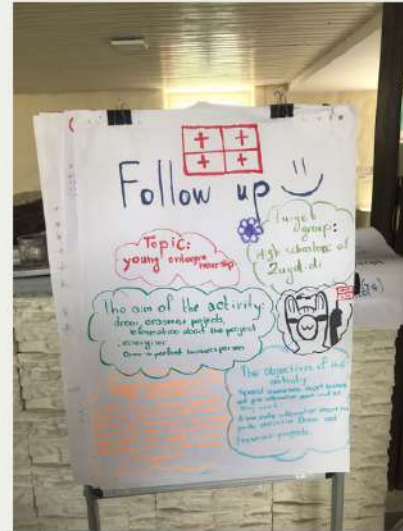
