Future in Our Hands is a young organization activities are mostly based on non-formal methods. We organize different kind of seminars, trainings, exchanges, summer camps, etc..full of games and energizers...We use this non formal method while our activities, which makes the learning process easier and much more interesting to the youth.

We work in different topics, involving different youth with different backgrounds, as we do believe that we need developed youth for our future development. Here is why we have different specialists working in different target group youth.

Cultural Projects.

We do our best to participate in increasing the diversity of approaches to developing public awareness of the value of heritage for society. Here is why we select cultural projects which will help up to promote this awareness among youth. We do believe that cultural awareness is a key to keeping the identity of the country and it is a key aspect for us to train to teach youth to learn about their own culture and to find ways of promoting it among others. So we find it important to inform youth and our local communities about environmental issues and how to change their behavior to support to stop the upcoming catastrophe. In the frames of environmental issues, we organize both local workshops and we had several international ones, where we shared our skills and learnt from the international groups.

Sport and healthy living is inseparable part of our projects. We want our youth to develop their mental wellbeing and live a healthy life. Here is why from time to time we organize both international and local exchanges, to promote this lifestyle and make it an important part of our youth's daily life.

We have organized several sport championships for the local clubs, sport days, day playing stations for kids, with different sport spots.

Health media literacy has been associated with exploring media's impact on making positive choices related to nutrition, exercise, body image, violence and substance abuse prevention.
